*A three (3) member Nomination Committee shall be appointed by the President in consultation with the Executive Committee for starting the election process at least five months before the forthcoming Annual Meeting of the General Membership. The President, the Vice President, the Treasurer and the Secretary shall be elected by the entire membership of the Association. The President and the Vice President will serve for a term of two years. The Treasurer and the Secretary shall serve for a period of four years. The Officers of the Association, i.e. the President, the Vice President, the Secretary and the Treasurer shall be elected by the entire membership and should be members of the association in good standing. The President shall be an individual of Indian origin.

**Up to three Members-at-Large will be appointed by the President with the consensus of the Executive Committee. The Members-at-Large will serve for two year term, but their period can be extended to one more term at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
